## \* Workshop 1: footage sales and licensing

## \* Workshop 2: Footage exchange / networking

How can footage sharing between Inédits members be made easier? We all hold footage showing geographical areas other than our own. Although donor and depositor agreements may bind us, it is possible and even desirable that this footage be shown in the places where it was filmed. How can such material be identified and shared?

How can such collaboration be lobbied for and implemented? Will it lead to increased joint projects between members?

### **INEDITS, FCAFF and FIAF TRAINING SESSION**

On 21 November from 13.00-17.00, prior to the two days of INEDITS meetings, a training session on the maintenance of substandard film equipment will take place. It will be open to technicians working in INEDITS, FCAFF and FIAF member organizations.
